The topic of the panel discussion **“Banking systems of the world: ensuring of the sustainable development, modernization of infrastructure, financial technologies and digital solutions”** includes the following issues:

1. Policies, mechanisms and tools of the response of governments and of the world banking systems regulators to the socio-economic challenges of the global pandemic.
2. Initiatives to ensure the sustainability and modernization of the banking infrastructure to increase financial stability.
3. Financial technologies and digital solutions to deepen financial inclusion and security in the face of new challenges and threats.
4. Criminal procedure aspects of financial and cyber crimes.

Thematic directions of the conference for testing the results of scientific researches:

1. Realization of the purposes of sustainable economic development COVID-19 crisis challenges.
2. Functioning and development of world’s banking systems: effectiveness and future steps.
3. Development of the financial industry in response to modern challenges.
4. Financial technologies and digital solutions to ensure financial inclusion and security in the face of new challenges and threats.
5. Management strategies, models and technologies under the conditions of digital transformations, innovations and pandemic constraints.
6. Innovations in key aspects of accounting, auditing and taxation.
7. New challenges for sectoral leadership in the field of information and communication technologies.
8. Criminal procedure aspects of financial and cyber crimes investigations.
9. Modern problems of forming the necessary knowledge and skills to meet current and future expectations of society and labour market.

Scientists, representatives of financial and credit institutions and enterprises, doctoral students, postgraduate students, students of higher educational institutions and all interested persons are invited to participate.

Conference languages: Ukrainian, Russian, English, Polish.

Form of conference participation: on-line in the form of video conferencing using the MOODLE platform. An electronic link to the videoconference will be sent to all registered participants on their e-mail addresses.

Conference participants are invited to publish:

- theses of the report in the conference proceedings;
- scientific paper in the International scientific and practical journal “*Financial space*” <https://fp.cibs.ubs.edu.ua/index.php/fp> (professional journal of “B” category according to the order of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine from 02.07.2020 № 886, Appendix 4).

An electronic version of the conference proceedings and an electronic certificate of the participation will be sent to participants on their e-mail addresses within a month after the end of the conference.

REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION

To participate in the conference it is obligatory to send application form and theses of the report to the e-mail ludmila08romanovska@gmail.com by **November 16, 2020**.

Materials are considered to be accepted if the participant receives an e-mail confirmation from the conference organizing committee.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE THESES OF THE REPORT

Thesis size is 3 pages in A4 format. All margins - 20 mm. Font - Times New Roman, 12, line spacing - 1. UDC is indicated in the upper left corner. The title is printed in bold capital letters symmetrically to the text. On the right, in one interval under the title the author’s name and initials, academic degree, academic title, position and name of the organization are given.

Thesis should include a minimum number of formulas and graphs that are performed with special MS Office editors. Formulas should be placed in the center and page number on the right edge. Drawings should be grouped as a single object. The list of used resources should be given in accordance with the requirements for the writing of scientific papers for professional journals. The author is responsible for the content and uniqueness of the provided material and the absence of academic plagiarism.

The conference application form must include the following information:

1. Name and surname.
2. Name of institution, scientific degree, academic title, position.
3. E-mail, contact phone.
4. Selected direction, thesis title.
